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N – Great although I know when hearing completely new words I have to hear them very slowly and several times. Did you know you have to hear a word about 50 times before it is successfully in your brain?

How can I ask you to repeat more slowly Fidan

F – Yavaş-yavaş təkrar edə bilərsən?

N – Ok Fidan Yavaş-yavaş təkrar edə bilərsən?

F -- Salam Necəsən

Mən yaxşıyam bəs sən?

Mən də yaxşıyam çox sağ ol

F - Salam Niki

N - Salam Fidan

F - Necəsən?

N - Mən yaxşıyam, bəs sən?

F - Mən də yaxşıyam, çox sağ ol.

N – These initial greetings are informal and great for when you know someone. Azeri language has formal and informal pronouns for the word you, the same as in French, Spanish and other languages. Informal that we just used, is sen. formal way to say you is siz

F - So in formal situations you will use the formal word for you.

Here is the same conversation but with a stranger or someone who you show respect to, such as someone who is older than you or your boss.

F - Salam Niki

N - Salam Fidan, necəsiniz?

F - Mən yaxşıyam, bəs siz?

N - Mən də yaxşıyam, çox sağ olun.

N - Great Fidan Did you hear how the sen endings changed to siz endings? Listen again

Salam, necəsiniz x 2

Mən yaxşıyam, bəs siz x 2

Mən də yaxşıyam, çox sağ olun x2

N - Ok so let hear the whole conversation again

F - Salam Niki

N - Salam Fidan, necəsiniz?

F - Mən yaxşıyam, bəs siz?

N - Mən də yaxşıyam, çox sağ olun

Thank you or goodbye

F - Sağ ol

F - Buyur

F - Görüşərik

F - Hələlik
